Emergency SOS by Apple

- Built-in feature for iOS 10.2 and later
- Allows iPhone users to get help when they are in an emergency situation
- Widgets and iWatch app support
- How to set it up?
- How to call emergency services automatically?

Emergency SOS

Setup and Operations

- Press the Power
 (Sleep/Wake) Button 5 times
 rapidly or hold the side
 buttons
- Emergency Slider: slide it from left to right







Emergency SOS

Setup

- Turn on Auto Call to skip the Emergency Slider step
- Countdown Sound to alert that you are calling them
- No need to turn on Location Services in advance
- Emergency Contacts versus Emergency Services
- New Fall Detection feature





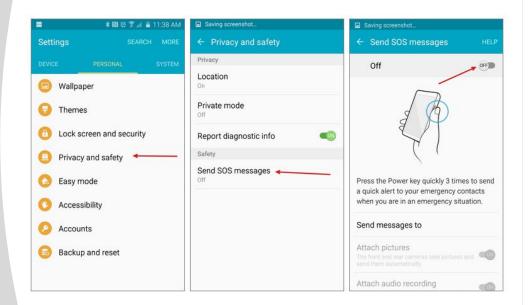




Emergency SOS

Android Setup

- Varies by smartphone
- Settings > Privacy and Safety
 - > Send SOS messages
- Set up Emergency Contacts
- Send pictures and / or audio recording to them

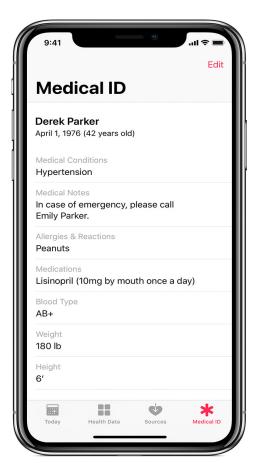
Health

Health App by Apple

- Built-in app for iOS 10.2 and later
- Gathers your health data to help you monitor progress
- Widgets, iWatch app and complications support
- Enter the age, height, weight and other physical attributes in the Personal Profile

Health App

- Create Medical ID:
 - Date of Birth
 - Medical Conditions
 - Medical Notes
 - Allergies and Reactions
 - Medications
 - ○Blood Type
 - Organ Donor
 - Oweight and Height
 - **OEmergency Contacts**
 - Share Medical ID when calling emergency services





Health App

- Counts your steps
- Tracks your running and walking distances
- Smart Watch automates the tracking of your activity data
- Based on the information entered in the Personal Profile, it calculates the calories burnt
- Activity, mindfulness, nutrition, sleep and many more



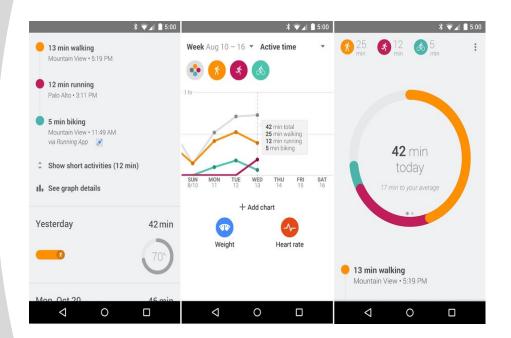






Health App

- Apple partners with major healthcare providers or services like Mayo Clinic, Florida Health System, Medisafe, etc. to adopt this app
- Synchronizes with MyChart app
- Android Google Fit app does track similar things
- Alternative: FitBit

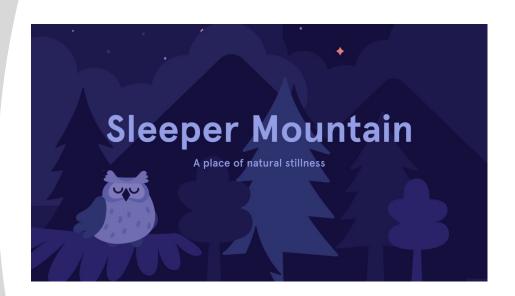


Headspace App

- iOS, iPadOS 10.2, Android
- Free Therapy or Tutorial Sessions with Three Major Focuses:
 - 1. Meditate
 - 2. Sleep
 - 3. Move
- Need to create an account to start
- Add buddies to experience them together
- Share your journey via text, emails or social media

Headspace App

- Guided meditation with explicit steps
 - Help focus what one should be doing instead of having the mind wandering off or letting your thoughts in
- Choices on the male or female voice
- Choices on the duration of each course: 3 to 60 minutes
- Targeted courses: work, kids, sleep, focus, stress and anxiety





Headspace App

Strengths:

- Beautiful, cute and effective graphics and videos
- Immersive music and / or background sound effect to create a zone for you to sink in
- Levels for advancement and achievement
- Library for lots of courses
- Reasonably accessible (but not 100%)





Headspace Plus

Features:

- Full Headspace experience:
 - 10 levels of Learn, Practice and Master
- A new medication every day
- Sleep sounds and bedtime exercises
- Move Mode for mind and body fitness

Subscription Options:

- \$69.99 annual subscription (\$5.99 per month) with first 14 days free
- \$12.99 per month with first 7 days free









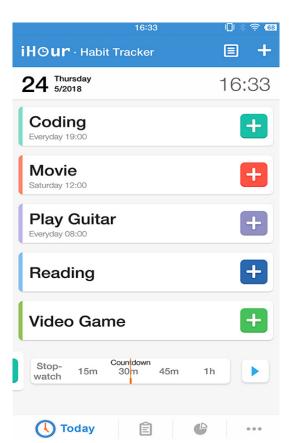


iHour – Habit and Skill Tracker App by Clover

- iOS, Android
- No need to create an account
- Task Planner
- Daily Tracker
- Visualization of your efforts with time statistics and achievements
- Customized icons

iHour – Habit and Skills Tracker

- Add in projects or skills on the fly
- Set up time commitment in the timeframe you want to gain the skill or finish the project
- Use it as a stop-watch to limit the time you can afford to spend
- Share with families and friends
- Very user-friendly

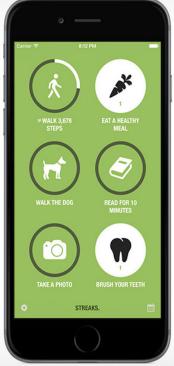


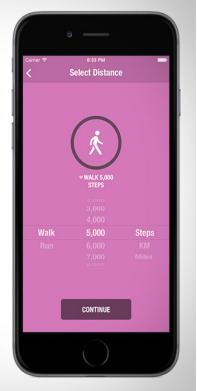


Streaks App by Crunchy Bagel

- Helps form good habits or break bad ones
- Tracks up to 12 tasks each day
- Automatically knows when you complete tasks
- Linked to the Health app
- Automatic reminder for tasks completion



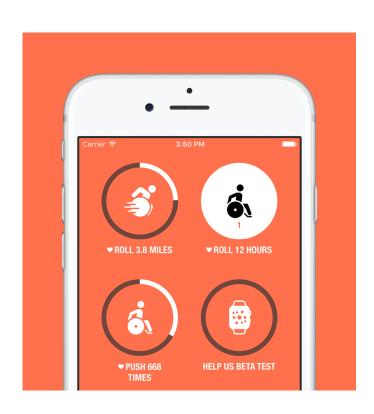

Stim' Art Scarlett App

- iOS, iPadOS and Android platforms. Its name in Android is called Scarlett, Adapted Brain Games
- An array of games that challenge every aspect of your memory
- Free version access to 13 games
- Designed for older adults and seniors to help stimulate cognitive abilities but may also be beneficial for users recovering from a traumatic brain injury

Stim' Art Scarlett App

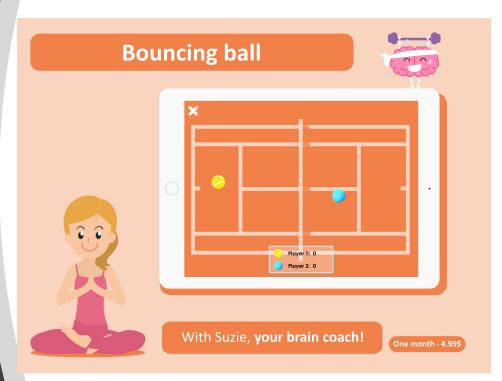
- Connecting bubbles works on sequential order of numbers
- Hunting Protruders find the odd word among four words
- Puzzle Plus rebuilding photos or paintings
- Quizzle USA like a Jeopardy game where you choose from culture, history or geography
- Color Mind Activity to remember colors presented
- A Text a Day displays an excerpt of American literature such as Virginia Wolf.





Stim' Art Scarlett App

- The Musical Ear choose from a sound or an instrument
- Brainstorm gives you a proverb to put in sequential order
- A Card a Date gives you 5 areas (persons, science, presidents, history or inventions) and the goal is to put each card in sequential order
- Twins match the cards
- Crazy Waterfall find the difference in symbols
- Bouncing Ball tap the tennis ball as quickly as possible
- Crazy Chessboard follow the design given on a board of 16 squares

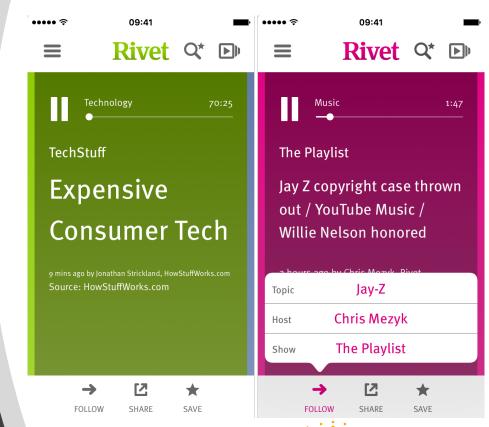

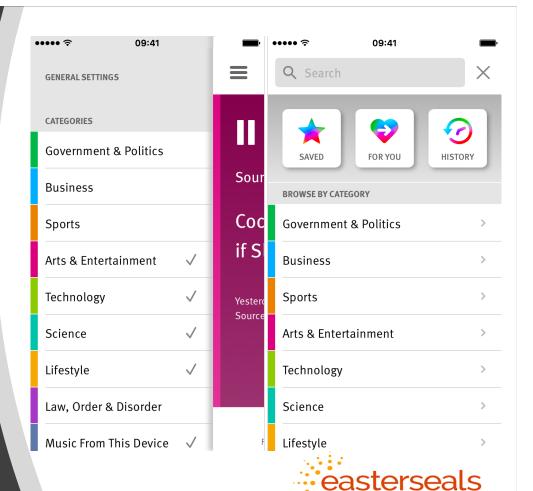
- Easy to use Swipe to skip or repeat stories
